Annual Enhancement Plan price increase - effective October 1, 2023

Maintaining older versions of an ERP system can be expensive and time-consuming. As the system ages, it becomes more complex to maintain, and finding skilled personnel who can support it can become difficult. As a result, the cost of providing maintenance for older versions of the ERP system can be higher than for newer versions.

Following the latest Enhancement plan announcement from Microsoft, the annual price of Enhancement plans (EP) will increase by 1 point for on-Prem products purchased through DPL.

For LS Nav Perpetual (2013-2018) / LS Central on BC on-Prem Perpetual the increase will be from 18% to 19% of PLP.

For older LS Nav versions such as: BRL AM / BRL-BE / Standard / Professional, the increase will be from 18% to 22% of PLP.

Migration to shared cloud - end of dedicated clusters

LS Retail has been on the journey of transitioning the LS Central solution toward the cloud. The *NoDLL* version of the POS, introduced in the LS Central 20.4 release, is followed by setting the scope in our installation to cloud in version 22. With this change we will start migrating customers operating on dedicated country clusters, managed partially by LS Retail, toward the public shared cluster, managed fully by Microsoft.

LS Central, along with all translations and country-specific apps, will go through full Microsoft AppSource verification in the coming weeks, as a prerequisite.
